

TOWN OF TREMPEALEAU
Ordinance to Regulate Parking of Vehicles
ORDINANCE # 2009-003

The Town Board of the Town of Trempealeau, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Trempealeau, by this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- a. The no parking of vehicles on the following town highway(s) in the Town of Trempealeau is subject to the following restrictions and limitations:

Starting at 11th Street going West to W24724 Park Road , 2000' as signed

- b. The town chairman, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- c. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture according to the codes of the Trempealeau County Sheriff Department and may be issued by any and all Deputy Sheriffs of the County of Trempealeau.

This ordinance is effective on publication and posting on Aug 28, 2009 (date)

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
