MINUTES OF THE 01/14/99 BOARD MEETING

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The minutes were reviewed; Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve the minutes; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Kathy Sonsalla was present in behalf of herself and Ken Sonsalla. The Board questioned what the name of the proposed road would be; Kathy reported it to be Sara Lane. Gerald Stellpflug moved to accept the road as a Town Road; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the Land Use Plan for the Town of Trempealeau. Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

A motion was called for with regard to the proposed Class B license for the Curling Club. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Mark Delaney appeared before the Board to inquire as to the status of the IH truck and replacing the rear end. George reported that, after investigation and discussion with other towns having the same problem, it was determined that the cost was prohibitive in terms of the trade-in value. Mark indicated he was curious because a motion had been made at the Annual Meeting to fix the rear end.

Cheryl Schwertel inquired as to whom is supposed to find out who has dogs in the Town. She is supposed to report any delinquent licenses and the list of dog owners she has is over ten years old. The Assessor might be able to supply some information and the Board members will check at the Towns Association meeting as to what other Towns do. Otherwise, Cheryl should just report no delinquent license fees.

The issue of Town employee benefits, vacations, etc. was tabled until the next meeting. The issue was raised that their pay was supposed to increase by \$.50/hour the first of the year. David Prondzinski moved and Gerald Stellpflug seconded that their pay be increased to \$11.50/hour. The motion carried.

Mark Rivera appeared before the Board to report that the name of the road in the Grover development will be Rivera Lane. Mark inquired when the next Board meeting would be, so the Board set the date as February 11, 1999, at 6:30 p.m.

The Board inquired as to whether Kramer has been paid for sand. We need to find out what the current price is.

Discussion returned to employee wages and the fact that part time employees (i.e. snowplowing) should also be increased by \$.50/hour at this time. David Prondzinski so moved; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

Cheryl Schwertel reported a problem with Dale Holley and the payment of taxes on mobile homes. Naomi C. Hale will prepare a letter.

Cheryl Schwertel raised the issue of whether or not we are going to rent the hall for rummage sales since the old Town Hall is no longer available and, if so, what would be charged. After discussion, Gerald Stellpflug made a motion that we **not** rent the hall for rummage sales. David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Don Todd did not appear; Gerald Stellpflug moved to table the matter; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

George Walski received a complaint about cars parked on the road in the Lakes area.

The bills were reviewed; David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

The Treasurer reported a balance as of December 31, 1998, of \$246,010.99, with \$94,337.61 being taxes deposited in December.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to adjourn, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
