**MINUTES OF THE 03/09/2000
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The minutes of the prior meeting were reviewed. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried. The Treasurer reported a balance as of February 29, 2000 of \$303,978.92.

David Prondzinski moved to pay the building loan in full, in the amount of \$54,423.98; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. Gerald Stellpflug moved to transfer funds, in the amount of \$54,423.98, from the General Fund to the Building Account to pay the loan amount. David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

David Prondzinski moved to accept the building rental rates for the Community Center as submitted and amended (copy attached to minutes); Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

George Walski requested the Board publish notice of an Informational Meeting to be run by the Jail Study Committee and held at the Town of Trempealeau Town Hall on March 23, 2000, at 7:30 p.m. The Clerk was directed to publish and post.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to hold the Annual Meeting at 7:00 p.m. on April 11, 2000. David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

The Transportation Survey was tabled until after the District Meeting in La Crosse.

David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

David Prondzinski moved to petition for Lehmann Road as a County Perspective Road; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The Clerk and the Chairman were directed to complete and submit the necessary paperwork.

David Prondzinski moved to delegate building inspection authority to the County; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The Clerk was directed to complete the form and submit it to the State.

David Prondzinski made a motion to have Kraemer Co. grind Sonsalla Road when they are working on State Road 54/93; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

The Clerk requested 5 election workers for the April 4 primary. The Board approved.

David Prondzinski moved to adjourn; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:33 p.m.

The next meeting was set for April 13, 2000, at 6:30 p.m.
