**MINUTES OF THE 05/11/2000
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The minutes of the prior meeting were reviewed. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried. The minutes of the Special Meeting held 04/25/00 were reviewed. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried. The Treasurer reported a balance as of April 30, 2000, of \$241,709.20. Gerald Stellpflug moved to accept, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

The Clerk was directed to write a letter to Rick McMillin regarding the deed for Swartling Road.

Bernard Seidling appeared requesting a waiver from the requirement of having all interior markers in prior to submission of his plans for State Plat Review. The Board indicated it could take no action since this was not on the agenda, but that Mr. Seidling could be on the June 8, 2000, meeting agenda.

The Clerk read the liquor license fees from the prior year, being as follows:

David Prondzinski made a motion to keep the liquor licensing fees the same as last year, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

The Board of Review was set for June 8, 2000, at 6:25 p.m. for the purpose of adjourning to a later date. The later date was established as June 27, 2000, from 6 to 8 p.m. The Clerk will contact the Assessor to set Open Book times.

Building permits were reviewed and approved as follows:

Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

No one appeared from the Senior Citizens and the matter was tabled.

The Clerk reported the Lions' request for a nomination for Citizen of the Year. Gerald Stellpflug nominated George Walski. David Prondzinski moved that the nominations be closed, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The Clerk will complete the application.

George Walski reported that the speed limit signs are now in place on Canar Road/Harris Road. George Walski also reported that NSP will be spraying in the Township.

Gerald Stellpflug moved that the Clerk send certified letters to NSP, WWCC, Rural Electric Cooperative, GTE/Century Telephone and Midwest Gas advising them that no further construction in the town road right of ways without prior approval from the Town Board.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to adjourn; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
