**MINUTES OF THE 07/10/02
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Building Permits:

2. Tim Vondrasek had a permit application for a sun porch addition. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

The Clerk was directed to send a letter to Jeff Jacobson and Stephanie Mikelson regarding fence view procedures. The Clerk was directed to send a letter to Paul Walsky to notify him regarding paying the fence view fee in advance.

Victor Hoff appeared before the Board regarding a request for a holding tank and whether or not there were any local rules governing this. He was informed that if it met County standards, it was acceptable to the Town.

Evergreen Cemetery made a request that the Town haul rock for their blacktopper. The Town agreed to do so.
