**MINUTES OF THE 09/12/02
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All Board Members were present.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the August 8, 2002 Board Meeting; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve the minutes of the August 21, 2002 Special Board Meeting; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Building Permits:

1. Brian and Rhonda Olson (Lot 6 on Rivera Lane) - David Prondzinski moved to approve the building permit; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The Olson's current address is 617 Hagar Street, La Crosse, WI 54603.
2. Todd Lakey presented a permit to locate on Schuh Road. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.
3. Jesse L. Fox (Spaulding Road) – David Prondzinski moved to approve the building permit; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Dahl, Deputy Clerk and acting Treasurer, reported a balance as of August 31, 2002 of \$419,328.83.

The Board reviewed the vouchers for August 13 to September 12, 2002. David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

Jon and Donna Vetsch appeared regarding a building permit request. Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

After review and discussion of all materials presented by the Deputy Clerk regarding the phone system and internet access, David Prondzinski moved to have two phone lines and connect to the internet through WWCC DSL. Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The Deputy Clerk will check into the modem requirements and any necessary computer upgrades for installation of the DSL.

The Deputy Clerk presented a request from the UW-Extension for a reduced rental fee. She also informed the Board that they have already paid for the use of the facilities. The Board vetoed and reduced rate.

The Building Inspector issue was again tabled until we can find a certified inspector.

Mike Woestman did not appear to present his request regarding a zoning change. The Board will take no action since no question has been presented.

David Prondzinski moved to give the old safe at the Old Town Hall to George Walski in consideration of the fact that he personally paid the bill to have the safe opened so that the contents could be removed to the New Town Hall vault. Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

The next board meeting was set for October 10, 2002 at 6:30 p.m.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to adjourn; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
