**MINUTES OF THE 05/08/2003  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All Board Members were present.

Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski called for a motion to adopt the agenda. Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

There were no public comments.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2003 Board Meeting; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Dahl, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of April 30, 2003 of \$306,773.14 in checking and \$62,000 in a Certificate of Deposit for a total of \$368,773.14.

Gerald Stellpflug made a motion to approve vouchers dated April 11, 2003 to May 8, 2003 for check numbers 12531 through 12570. David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

**Building Permits:**

1. James & Tiphany Kokott: David Prondzinski moved to approve; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.
2. Centerville Homes: Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve the Conditional Use Permit Application for AT&T Wireless for the purpose of constructing a wireless communications facility on the Don and Bruce Brenengen property located off Hwy 35. David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried. A letter of approval will be sent.

**Building issues:**

The electrical needs to be checked in the community center.

The clerk received an estimate on a new copy machine. It was decided to keep the old one.

A solicitor was around with an aerial picture of the community center for purchase. It was decided to not buy the picture.

The clerk received one estimate from a company for a handicap door opener. She was directed to contact local companies for an installed quote.

Gerald Stellpflug made a motion to modify the Rules and Regulations for the Community Center. Change #11 to also mop the cooler and add that there are no candles allowed at events. David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Sidney Moen was contacted to be a building inspector for the Township. He declined but would maybe do it at a later date. Gordon Van Dunk will be contacted again. The issue was again tabled.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the application for a Class A beer license and a Class A liquor license for Donald Todd and Steven Dick who have purchased the Centerville Stop and Shop and Café from Cyril Pehler upon the condition that we received notice from Mr. Pehler of surrender of the current license. Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to raise the Class A Beer license from \$10.00 to \$25.00 with the rest remaining at the same rate for the 2003/2004 year. David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

The date for the Board of Review was set for June 10, 2003 at 6:30 p.m.

A special Town meeting was set for July 9, 2003 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of asking the voters to authorize the purchase of land within the town.

The next meeting was set for June 10, 2003 at 6:35 p.m. David Prondzinski moved to adjourn; Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
