**MINUTES OF THE 12/11/2003  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All Board Members were present.

Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski called for a motion to adopt the agenda, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

There were no public comments.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve the minutes of the November 13, 2003 Board Meeting; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Dahl, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of November 30, 2003 of \$253,194.42 in checking and \$62,615.95 in Certificates of Deposits for a total of \$315,810.37.

David Prondzinski moved to transfer \$450 from the general fund to the recycling/solid waste disposal account, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

The Board reviewed the vouchers for November 14, 2003 to December 11, 2003. Gerald Stellpflug moved to pay the bills; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

There were no building permits.

As a service to new homebuilders the Town has provided rock for driveways. With the number of houses going up it is getting quite expensive to do this. Gerald Stellpflug moved to quit supplying rock for new driveways as of January 1, 2004, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

The Clerk/Treasurer updated the Board on the Beverly Locke property. Correspondence has been received from the District Attorney. George Walski will call Laurie Clements, Trempealeau County Health Department, to let them know we want some action taken.

David Prondzinski made a motion to add \$5 to the following building inspector fees for paperwork: Garages and accessory buildings - \$65.00, Porches - \$65.00, All other construction (per item added) - \$80.00, Decks - \$35.00, Pool-underground - \$35.00, Fire damage - \$80.00, and Wrecking permits - \$30.00, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

David Prondzinski moved to not sign the American Planning Association resolution, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

Joe Wavra came before the Board requesting a letter supporting his putting a kennel on property he wants to buy in our Township. The Board also stated he would need a length to width variance for the property he intends to build on. David Prondzinski moved to approve the kennel license providing it is not used for German Shepherds, Pit bulls, Rottweilers or any other vicious dog breeds and also the length to width variance for his property, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried. The Clerk/Treasurer was directed to write a letter to Trempealeau County Zoning.

Jon Schwichtenberg representing Short Elliott Hendrickson Inc. appeared before the Board stating they are working with the Dept of Transportation on an Access Control Project for U.S. Highway 53/State Highway 54 from LaCrosse County to Centerville. They are currently doing field studies and meeting with municipal boards.

Jerry Saterbak, Architect, appeared before the Board stating he was interested in working on the new town shop building and the salt shed. He will do a work up and report back next month.

The Clerk/Treasurer ask the Board what they wanted to do with the CD due January 5, 2004. She was directed to call around closer to the date to get rates and select the highest one.

The next meeting was set for January 8, 2004.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:40 p.m., David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.
