**MINUTES OF THE 09/04/2007  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All Board Members were present.

Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski moved to adopt the agenda, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

**Public Comments.** –George Bartels, president of the Trempealeau Youth Sports Club, reviewed the program. The program is growing. They would like one of the board members to sit on a solutions committee they are forming.

Gerald Stellpflug moved to approve the minutes of the August 9, 2007 regular meeting; David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Dahl, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of August 31, 2007 of \$37,287.65 in checking, \$328,936.82 in the money market account and \$84,000.82 in a certificate of deposit for a total of \$450,225.29. \$100,000 was transferred into the money market account in August and \$25,000 was transferred from the money market to the regular checking account to cover September's expenses.

The Board reviewed the vouchers for August 10, 2007 through September 4, 2007. David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills, Gerald Stellpflug seconded and the motion carried.

**Building Permits -**

Phil Wernert presented a permit to place a manufactured house on his property at W24333 State Road 54/93, Galesville, WI. David Prondzinski moved to approve, Gerald Stellpflug seconded. The motion carried.

It was decided to have Nortrax bring the maintainer down for us to try.

David Prondzinski moved to enter into an agreement with Prochnow Assessing Service for the Town's 2008 assessment in the amount of \$11,000; Gerald Stellpflug seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Thursday, September 6, 2007 at 8:00 a.m. was set for viewing and rating the roads.

It was decided the clerk/treasurer would take the NIMS training on line first.

**Building Issues –**

- ✓ The rest of the parking lot behind the community center will be blacktopped when the County blacktops Schuh Road.

**Correspondence –**

- ✓ According to the State Lab of Hygiene, the soils on the Dale Fink farm are well within the normal range for naturally-occurring metals in soil.
- ✓ Roger Losinski received a final notice to bring his junkyard into compliance with zoning regulations.
- ✓ Board agendas need to be more specific.
- ✓ The Clerk/Treasurer will be attending election training to be in compliance with state regulations.
- ✓ The Clerk/Treasurer needs to be re-appointed every three years.
- ✓ Discussion on election costs if the school district would decide to have a special election.

The next meeting is set for October 11, 2007 at 6:30 p.m.

David Prondzinski moved to adjourn the meeting; Gerald Stellpflug seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
