**MINUTES OF THE 12/03/2007  
Special Town Meeting**

The Town Chairman called to order the Special Town meeting for the purpose of adjusting the 2007 payable 2008 town tax levy. There were 3 residents and 1 non-resident in attendance.

The clerk/treasurer explained the reason for the adjustment to the levy approved at the November 8, 2007 town meeting. The levy limit worksheet came late and was different than previous years. It put the Town over the allowable levy limit by \$24,212.00 which would reduce the amount of shared revenue received from the state.

David Prondzinski moved to reduce the levy by \$24,212.00 which brings the local levy to \$372,100.00 plus the county special tax amount of \$64,332.00 for a total of \$436,432.00; Gerald Stellpflug seconded. A ballot vote was taken. A yes vote will reduce the levy. A no vote will leave the levy the same. With 3 yes votes and 0 no votes, the motion carried.

David Prondzinski moved to increase the capital equipment fund by \$10,000.00 and lower the highway construction fund by \$34,212.00 to bring the budget into balance; Gerald Stellpflug seconded. A voice vote was taken. With 3 yes votes and 0 no votes, the motion carried.

David Prondzinski moved to adjourn the special town meeting; Gerald Stellpflug seconded. The meeting adjourned at 8:10 a.m.
