**MINUTES OF THE 02/14/2008
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All Board Members were present.

Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski moved to adopt the agenda, Gerald Stellflug seconded and the motion carried.

Public Comments. – Ryan Hilton asked to be considered to represent the Town on the Fire Board, if a position became available.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the January 10, 2008 regular meeting; Gerald Stellflug seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Dahl, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of January 31, 2008 of \$77,675.88 in checking and \$801,854.96 in the money market account for a total of \$879,530.84. Transfers in the amount of \$720,000.00 were made from checking to the money market account. On February 18, 2008 \$775,000.00 will be transferred back into checking to pay the bills.

Total taxes collected for this year was \$1,634,970.57. Total paid back to the schools and the county was \$1,394,220.44. Town's share to date is \$240,750.13.

The Board reviewed the vouchers for January 11, 2008 through February 14, 2008. Gerald Stellflug moved to pay all bills, David Prondzinski seconded and the motion carried.

Building Permits –

Andy Rasmussen presented a permit to build a new house on lot 8, Mountain View East. David Prondzinski moved to approve the permit; Gerald Stellflug seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Matthew Oliver presented a permit to build a new house on lot 57, Prairie Bluffs. Gerald Stellflug moved to approve the permit; David Prondzinski seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Gary Ersepke and Todd Pyka would like to build a three car garage on their property at N15987 Harris Road. They would need a variance to build. They only have a half acre lot. When the board is out inspecting roads this spring, they will stop in and take some measurements.

Kathy Sonsalla presented a preliminary 10 year plan for her property. She would like to develop lots 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 at this time. The board felt there needed to be some changes and gave these suggestions:

- ✓ Extend Hogan Lane through lot 8 to make a connection with Spaulding Road
- ✓ Or finish the whole loop and develop lots 16 & 17 also.

The road must then be blacktopped prior to town ownership.

David Prondzinski moved to put the road bans on as needed; Gerald Stellflug seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Dates selected for Board of Review were May 13, 14, 15, 20 or 22nd. The clerk/treasurer will inform the assessor of these dates.

Discussion was held on the purchase of a road broom. George Walski is to get some bids and return with the information at the next meeting.

Piling of snow in the road right-of-way was tabled until next month.

Building Issues –

- ✓ A request was again received for the G-E-T Post Prom committee asking if the Board would donate the use of the building for their event. David Prondzinski moved to grant the request; Gerald Stellflug seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Correspondence –

- ✓ A request was received from a homeowner in Prairie Bluffs to post a 25 mph speed limit there and have a possible police drive through.
- ✓ Postage is going up again. The forever stamp can be purchased at \$.41 and be good until we run out. The Board was in favor of purchasing some.
- ✓ A request was received from a resident about the possibility of putting a guard rail along the Harris pit area of Schuh Road.
- ✓ The clerk/treasurer stated she would have 2 shifts of 5 election workers for the upcoming Presidential Preference election.

The next meeting is set for March 13, 2008 at 6:30 p.m.

David Prondzinski moved to adjourn the meeting; Gerald Stellflug seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
