**MINUTES OF THE 4/08/2009
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman George Walski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All Board Members were present.

Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski moved to adopt the agenda; Gerald Stellflug seconded and the motion carried.

Public Comments. – None

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the March 12, 2009 regular meeting; Gerald Stellflug seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Dahl, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of March 31, 2009 of \$19,058.73 in checking and \$269,610.94 in the money market account for a total of \$288,669.67.

The Board reviewed the vouchers for March 13, 2009 through April 8, 2009. David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills, Gerald Stellflug seconded and the motion carried.

Building Permits –

The clerk/treasurer presented a building permit for a new home to be built off Spaulding Road from Paul Sonsalla. David Prondzinski moved to deny the permit as presented; Gerald Stellflug seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Rhonda Olson appeared before the board to discuss re-zoning her property on Rivera Lane from R-20 to agricultural. They currently have horses and would need to re-zone to keep them. The covenant for Rivera Lane also states that there can be no farm animals allowed. This would need to be changed before re-zoning would be considered. David Prondzinski moved to table this issue until the covenant is changed; Gerald Stellflug seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

A request for reimbursement was received from Richard Phillips for mailbox damage due to snowplowing. Gerald Stellflug moved to ask him to present evidence that the snowplow damaged his mailbox; David Prondzinski seconded. The clerk/treasurer was directed to write him a letter with this request.

The clerk/treasurer presented the 2008 audit received from the auditors.

Tim and Lori Sharpe have an option to buy a lot in Kay Estates. They would like to find out how far the town road goes before they sign. They were told they need to find out what the deed for that lot states.

Colin Hirner requested to be removed as an alternate from the Board of Review. David Prondzinski moved to accept the request; Gerald Stellflug seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.

Discussion was held on the temporary storage permit form. Changes will be made and brought to the next meeting.

A date will need to be set for to demonstration the noise level of the race cars on the track built by Jeff Matejka. The clerk/treasurer was directed to contact him for a date.

Wayne Wilber, Dennis Bortle and David Prondzinski were sworn in as new board members.

Building Issues - None.
