Public Comments. – None.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2010 regular meeting; Wayne Wilber seconded and the motion carried.

Doris Dahl, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of June 30, 2010 of \$50,556.83 in checking and \$259,123.34 in the money market account for a total of \$309,680.17.

The Board reviewed the vouchers for June 11, 2010 through July 8, 2010. David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills, Dennis Bortle seconded and the motion carried

Building Permits – None.

Jim Brush appeared in regards to the assessment on his property. He feels he was assessed wrong for the last 12 years and is going to pursue collecting on a charge back claim. (See attached letter)

Dan Schreiner, Emergency Manager for Trempealeau County, informed the Board on preparing an Emergency Operations Plan. There is no deadline, however there needs to be one in place in the event claims need to be filed for emergency disasters.

The health insurance rates starting September 2010 increased 9%.

Building Issues –

- A Sanitary Survey was taken on May 20, 2010 by a DNR-Groundwater specialist. The survey did not find anything that required correcting at this time.

Correspondence –

- A thank you was received from Fleis Insurance Agency for remaining with the for the Town's insurance coverage.
- A thank you from the Trempealeau County Fair was received for the \$500 contribution.
- Mark Delaney and Lynita Docken rezoned 2.64 acres of their property on Delaney Road for their winery.
- Final assessment for 2010 is \$129,087,700 which is up \$500,300 from 2009.
