**MINUTES OF THE 08/08/2013
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman Ken Farley called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All members were present.

Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski moved to adopt the agenda, Dennis Bortle seconded and the motion carried.

Public Comments. – None.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the July 11, 2013 regular meeting, Dennis Bortle seconded and the motion carried with a voice vote.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the July 24, 2013 special board meeting, Dennis Bortle seconded and the motion carried with a voice vote.

Doris Dahl, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of July 31, 2013 of \$95,964.33 in checking and \$304,301.59 the regular money market account, \$150,000.00 in the contingency money market account, \$54,000.00 in the equipment money market account and \$2000.00 in the health savings money market account for a total of \$606,865.92.

The Board reviewed the vouchers July 11, 2013 through August 8, 2013. David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills, Dennis Bortle seconded and the motion carried.

Ken Farley presented a plaque to outgoing Chairman Wayne Wilber thanking him for his 4 years of service to the Town. A duplicate plaque will also be placed in the town office.

Building Permits. –

- Joe Plunger presented a permit to build a new house at N13376 Primrose Road, Prairie Bluffs Addition. David Prondzinski moved to approve the permit; Dennis Bortle seconded. The motion carried with a voice vote.
- Bob Byrne did not show up.

Residents from the Buckskin Addition appeared voicing their concerns about the large number of dogs one resident has on their property on Arabian Lane. The dogs run at large, leaving messes on neighbor's yards, chase children and rip through the garbage. The clerk had issued a kennel license, but has since rescinded it and returned the amount of money difference between 4 tags and the late fees and a kennel license. The residents stated their Restrictions to Lots does not allow more than 2 dogs and 2 cats. The Board informed the residents that the Town could not enforce their Restrictions to Lots. They would have to do that themselves. Chairman Farley read the letter Mark and Angela Bryant had received from the Trempealeau County Land Management stating they had until August 14 to remove the dogs, file a conditional use permit to have more than 5 dogs or be fined and also a letter from the Trempealeau County Health Department giving them until August 19 to clean up the garbage or face further enforcement activities. Mr. Stalzer asked if this could be placed on the agenda for next month.

Building Issues –

- The parking lot sealing will be done by Cory Abel as scheduling allows.
- The painting of the sign will be more costly than anticipated. Mr. Farley was directed to get bids.

Correspondence –

- Mr. Bortle has received a letter back from the DOT in regards to ownership of 11th street and a portion of Lake Road.
- Just prior to the meeting tonight, Anna Klein presented the Board with their typed version of a “Scare Gun Permit” – under protest. The clerk informed her no action would be taken tonight since it was not on the agenda.
- The clerk also has received the quarterly fireboard meeting minutes and financial packet.

The next meeting is set for September 12, 2013 at 6:30 p.m.

David Prondzinski moved to adjourn the meeting; Dennis Bortle seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
