**MINUTES OF THE 6/25/2015
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman Ken Farley called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. All members were in attendance. Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski moved to adopt the agenda, Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried.

Building Issues – Ralph JaDoul presented a zoning application on behalf of Steve Lathrop to the board regarding building a house on Schubert Road. After discussion David Prondzinski made a motion to approve the application. Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried by voice vote.

Discussion was held regarding the pricing of used culverts. After discussion it was decided that a 48” x 30’ culvert delivered would be \$400 and a 36” x 30’ culvert delivered would be \$250. Leonard Hovell will contact Leroy Hovell about the culvert he is interested in.

Discussion was held regarding insurance limits and costs. David Prondzinski made a motion to award the insurance bid to Fleis Insurance. Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried by voice vote. The clerk will send letters to both Fleis Insurance and Rural Insurance regarding the decision.

David Prondzinski made a motion to pay Doug Nichols Jr. \$500 for property damage caused by the town while mowing. Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried by voice vote.

Discussion was held regarding the speed limit issue on Schubert Road. An ordinance was presented lowering the speed limit to 35 mph from 1,000’ before Fairway Drive to 1,000’ past Primrose Road. David Prondzinski made a motion to adopt the ordinance. Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried by voice vote. The clerk will have the ordinance published in the Trempealeau County Times. The chairman spoke regarding striping Schubert Road. An estimate of cost was received from the County to double yellow stripes and paint fog lines on Schubert Road. David Prondzinski made a motion to complete all striping. Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried by voice vote. The chairman will contact the County regarding proceeding with the project. A possible purchase of a speed radar trailer was discussed and tabled until more information is received. The sheriff’s office will be contacted to request they place their trailer on Schubert Road as soon as possible.

The chairman gave an update on road maintenance in process. The county is paving Armstrong Bridge and N. Park Road today. William Miller lane was discussed. It will be taken care of in 2016. The chairman contacted Kraemer Co. regarding the repair of Whistle Pass Road. He was informed that they had just awarded the bid and the work would be completed in a week or two.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 9, 2015 at 6:30 p.m.

David Prondzinski moved to adjourn the meeting; Ted Konkel seconded. The meeting adjourned at 9:15 a.m.
