**MINUTES OF THE 7/9/2015
REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

Chairman Ken Farley called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. All members were in attendance. Open meeting certification laws were met. David Prondzinski moved to adopt the agenda, Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried.

Roger Losinski spoke regarding his interest in rezoning 20 acres of his property for a campground. This will be placed on the agenda for the July 23, 2015 meeting.

Sonja Byrne, Clerk/Treasurer reported a balance as of June 30, 2015 of \$360,110.30 in checking, \$214,821.62 in the regular money market account, \$251,818.90 in the contingency money market account, \$1,000.00 in the health savings money market account and \$540,056.27 in the CapX money market account.

David Prondzinski moved to approve the minutes of the June 11, 2015 and the June 25, 2015 board meetings. Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried with a voice vote. The Board reviewed the vouchers from June 12, 2015 through July 9, 2015. David Prondzinski moved to pay all bills, Ted Konkel seconded and the motion carried by voice vote.

Carlton Klein brought forth the issue of making a claim against the town for corn loss last fall. Carlton was asked to bring something in writing showing what exactly what he was requesting. The town will then forward the information to the town's attorney for review.

An update on summer road maintenance was given:

North Park Road is ready for sealcoating.

Whistle Pass has been fixed by Kraemer.

Linden Hill seeding has been completed. The clerk will get the road measurements for the Town of Arcadia, Town of Gale and Town of Trempealeau so the road can be permanently marked.

Nichols Lane and Walsky Lane are being blade patched to get ready for sealcoating.

Schubert Road will be having new signs put up by the County. The County will also be striping the road. Trempealeau County will be placing their radar sign on Schubert Road temporarily.

The issue of Little Tamarack Creek will be discussed at the July 23, 2015 meeting. The clerk will contact Karen Kalvelage regarding viewing the area so the work can get started.

Corey Feyen presented an idea to Ken Farley regarding having a joint pool committee consisting of the Town of Caledonia, Village of Trempealeau and Town of Trempealeau.

The bridge inspection report was received. The Town employees will complete what items they are able on Sonsalla Bridge. The County will help this fall to “put a bandage” on it. The rating is too high to get it on the registry. Bortle Road work will be completed by the town employees.

The next meeting is scheduled for July 23, 2015 at 8:00 a.m.

David Prondzinski moved to adjourn the meeting; Ted Konkel seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
