

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF
HIGH-POWERED RIFLES IN THE TOWN OF
TREMPEALEAU, TREMPEALEAU COUNTY,
WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Trempealeau, Trempealeau
County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Definition. "High-Powered Rifle" is defined
to mean any rifle with a bore greater than that of .22 caliber.

SECTION 2. Prohibited Use. No person shall at any time
carry or transport any high-powered rifle in the Town of Trempealeau
unless the same be securely enclosed in a carrying case; and no
person shall at any time discharge any high-powered rifle within
the limits of the Town of Trempealeau.

SECTION 3. Penalty. Any person violating the provisions
of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, forfeit the sum of
Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default
of payment of such forfeiture, shall be imprisoned in the county jail
until such forfeiture is paid or until the expiration of ninety (90)
days.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect
and be in force from and after its passage and posting.
