## TOWN OF TREMPEALEAU ORDINANCE TO LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON SCHUBERT ROAD 2015-001

The Town Board of the Town of Trempealeau, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin has specific authority under s. 346.57, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Trempealeau, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides for the authority for the town board to reduce the speed limits on certain roads in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 346.57 (4) FIXED LIMITS, (j), Wis. Stats., as pertains to any town road where on either side of the road within any 1,000 feet along such road the buildings in use for business, industrial or residential purposes fronting thereon average less than 150 feet apart, it is understood that, a decrease limit is within the Town's jurisdiction and does not need Wisconsin Department of Transportation approval, speed limits on the road known as Schubert Road from 1,000 feet north of Fairway Drive through 1,000 feet south of Primrose Road are reduced to 35 miles per hour.
- B. Pursuant to 349.11(5), Wis. Stats., the town chairperson, or his designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town roads, in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication as required under Wis. Stat. § 60.80.
