

TOWN OF TREMPEALEAU
ORDINANCE TO LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON 11TH STREET
2016-001

The Town Board of the Town of Trempealeau, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin has specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

The Town Board of the Town of Trempealeau, by this ordinance, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and by a roll call vote by a majority of the town board present and voting, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain roads in the town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., speed limits on certain Town of Trempealeau town roads are reduced or modified as follows: 25 mph on 11th Street starting at the intersection of Fremont Street and continuing east to the Town of Caledonia Line. The east end of 11th Street is primarily a residential area with 20 residences within approximately 3,400'. 11th Street has dangerous curves around the pond area, blind driveways and school bus stops making this a potentially hazardous situation.


B. Pursuant to 349.11(5), Wis. Stats., the town chairperson, or his designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town roads, in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.


This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication as required under Wis. Stat. § 60.80.


